CITY/STATE – LOCATION: Albuquerque, New Mexico – Zia Rifle & Pistol Club Clubhouse
(6 lane - 50 ft indoor range)

ELIGIBILITY: This competition is open to all competitors born in 1987 or later.
All competitors must be US Citizens and individual members of USA Shooting.
Current USA Shooting cards must be presented. We cannot send in your scores without verifying your membership. Competitors holding expired member cards will be allowed to pay the \$20 Junior member annual fee.
Due to the short timeline, membership forms will be available at the match. Renewing Junior members is \$20 and new (first time) Junior memberships are \$10 in addition to the match entry fee.

RESIDENCE: Each competitor may claim residence in only one state and must declare the state of residence on the entry form. Residents are eligible for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place USA Shooting State Champion medallions. Nonresidents may compete for automatic and at-large invitations to the National Championship and are encouraged to do so.

STATE RESIDENT QUALIFIERS: USA Shooting will issue official invitations to the National Junior Olympic Shooting Championships (NJOSC) for the high scoring male and high scoring female resident from each State JOSC, provided they fire a minimum qualifying score. Resident collegiate and/or military competitors are eligible for the state resident champion awards and are also eligible for resident state qualifier invitations.



ENTRY:

Shooters ***may not*** compete in more than one state JOSC. Juniors who fire in their own home state JOSC will not be allowed to shoot in another state. Juniors from states which are not holding a state JOSC and those who cannot attend their own state JOSC will be allowed to enter the automatic/at-large division in another state. At entry, non-resident juniors must declare that they are shooting for an at-large/automatic invitation.

Residents may choose to enter the Automatic/At-large category instead of the Resident Qualifier category if they are confident they can shoot above the automatic score and secure an invitation. This would allow another competitor to receive the State Qualifier invitation.

- A. Resident Qualifier** – Competitors shooting in their declared state of permanent residency. Competitors in this category are eligible to be the state resident qualifier to the National JOSC.
- B. Automatic/At Large** – Competitors shooting in other than their declared state of residency are eligible for at-large/automatic invitations to the National JOSC.

CATEGORIES:

The following categories will be used for individual competition:
(Based on the age the competitor will be in the year 2007.)
Junior (J1); age 18-20; competitors born from 1987-1989
Intermediate Junior (J2); age 15-17; competitors born from 1990-1992
Sub-Junior (J3); age 14 & under; competitors born in 1993 or later.

RULES:

Current USA Shooting Rules will govern
Competitors are reminded that it their responsibility for knowing and conforming to these rules.

COURSE OF FIRE: Both Men and Women will shoot a 3x20 match

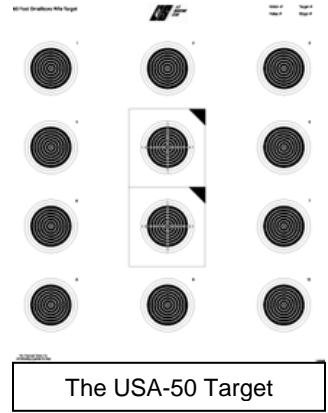
TIME LIMIT: Both Men and Women will have 2 hours and 15 minutes to fire on pre-hung targets

EQUIPMENT: [Eye and Ear protection is mandatory on the Zia ranges.](#)
In general: Any rifle firing the .22 (5.6mm) Long Rifle cartridge that conforms to the USA Shooting Rifle Rules is permitted.
All Rifles and other equipment must conform to the USA Shooting Rifle Rules.

SIGHTS: Any sight not containing a lens or system of lenses is permitted.
Sights must fully conform to section 7.4.2.3 of the USA Shooting Rules

- DISTANCE:** 50 feet
- TARGETS:** USA-50 Targets will be used (2 sighter & 10 Record)
(example shown)
- COACHING:** Coaching will not be permitted after the prep period Begins.
- SCORING PROTESTS:** A scoring protest fee of \$1.00 per shot may be charged
- TIES:** All ties will be broken in accordance with USA Shooting Rules
- PARTICIPATION PINS:** A Junior Olympic participation pin provided by USA Shooting will be given to each competitor (providing pins are requested by the sponsor).
- AWARDS:**

Provided by USA Shooting – USA Shooting will provide a gold medallion for the top resident individual, silver medallion for the 2nd place resident individual and a bronze medallion for the 3rd place resident individual. Unused awards must be returned to USAS.

Provided by the Sponsoring Organization – First thru Third rosettes will be awarded in each age group (J1, J2, & J3) to those shooters not awarded medallions.
- MAKE ENTRY:** Entries should be made using the entry form enclosed with this program. Each competitor must have an entry form ... make copies as necessary.
- ENTRY FEE:** **TOTAL INDIVIDUAL ENTRY FEES:**
 \$12.00 per competitor for advanced entry
 \$20.00 per competitor for late entry
(A USA Shooting Registration fee of \$8.00 per individual will be sent to USA Shooting with scores at the completion of the match.)
- ENTRIES CLOSE:** Advance entries will close **November 25, 2006**. Entries will be accepted to range capacity. Every effort will be made to accept all competitors who enter before the closing date. Make checks to **VC4HSS**.

- LATE ENTRIES:** Entries made after the closing date will be accepted only up to range capacity. As mentioned above, the late entry fee is \$20.00
- CANCELLATIONS:** Cancellations received by December 2, 2006 will receive a full refund.



SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

Multiple relays will be fired to accommodate all pre-entered competitors. Competitors checking in after the designated relay time are “late competitors” and may be accommodated in a later relay up to range capacity. The entry fee will not be refunded if there are no later lanes available for late competitors

Each 2-1/4 hour relay will consist of:

- a **5 minute period** will be given to hang targets
- a **10 minute period** will be provided for competitors to bring equipment to the line and setup. All rifles must be brought to the line in a case. When removed from the case the rifle will be made safe, and an Open Chamber Indicator (OCI) is to be inserted. OCI's will be made available
- a **10 minute prep period** will be given – dry fire only –
- **The 2-1/4 hour firing stage.** Competitors will shoot targets in the Prone, Standing, Kneeling order at their own timing. At the end of their firing, the competitor must make their rifle safe and insert their OCI.
- **After all competitors** have completed firing, a 10 minute equipment teardown period will be given

Lanes will be assigned by lottery at check in.

DIRECTIONS TO RANGE:

ZIA RIFLE & PISTOL CLUB

1.8 miles south of Rio Bravo on Broadway to Bobby Foster Road.
East on Bobby Foster Road across I-25 to Los Picaros Road.
Left at the “T” on Los Picaros and follow the signs to Zia Rifle & Pistol Club.

RANGE ACCESS: ZIA Rifle & Pistol Club is a private range.

You must be a member of Zia to get thru the access gate by yourself.

Non-members must be escorted.

At one hour and one half hour before each Relay Start Time (above), a club member will arrive at the gate to unlock and escort the competitors to the clubhouse. The access gate will only be attended at those times.

It is the responsibility of the competitor to be at the Zia gate **AT LEAST** one half hour before the Relay Start Time to meet the escort. Competitors arriving late and not checking in by the Relay Start Time will be deemed “Late Competitors”. It is suggested that competitors make the one hour before start time access time.

There is no food or water at Zia, so make sure you bring some food and plenty of water.



OTHER INFORMATION:

- **STATE & AUTOMATIC QUALIFYING SCORES:**

All state Junior Olympic smallbore rifle matches must be conducted using USA Shooting Rules. The course of fire must be 60 shots (3x20) for both men and women at 50 feet.

One male and one female State Qualifier will be invited per state provided they fire above the minimum required “State Qualifier” score. Automatic invitations are issued to all who fire above the minimum “automatic invite” score. Remaining at-large competitors will be ranked by age category and score and invited up to range capacity.
