DIRECTIONS: I-40 East to the Juan Tabo Exit. North on Juan Tabo to Lomas Blvd.
East On Lomas Blvd to the west parking lot. Enter gym complex on west
side doors

ELIGIBILITY:
Individual competition is open to all juniors who meet the eligibility requirements of NRA rule 2.3. Competitors may enter more than one Sectional Tournament, but may fire in only one of each discipline of Sectional, for official record, during the same calendar year. **Sporter and Precision are separate but equal competitions and a shooter may shoot in both disciplines.**

Team competition is open to all juniors who meet the requirements of NRA Rules 2.3 and 2.11. Teams consist of four (4) firing members and a Team Captain (who must be designated) who may also be a firing member of the team. Teams may enter any Sectional tournament, but may fire in only one of each discipline of a Sectional during the same calendar year. Teams must fire their score at one location. Teams must be from one club and designated prior to firing. If you shoot in the JROTC category, your entire team must be JROTC also, if one team member fires a precision rifle, that team will compete in the precision classification.
Teams MUST meet Rule 2.11 and PRACTICE together on a regular basis as well as shoot tournaments together. NO PICK-UP TEAMS!!

NRA Membership is encouraged but not required:
Juniors competing may belong to an affiliated club. In order to enter scores of competitors in the computer classification system, an NRA number must be used. If you are a member of NRA, indicate your membership number. If you are not an NRA Member, use your classification card number if one has been assigned. If a special number has not been assigned, NRA will assign one when an accumulation of shots is sufficient (rule 19.15).



ADVANCED ENTRIES PREFERRED –

**Advanced Entries accepted until Friday, February 2, 2007.
Only paid advanced entries made with the enclosed form will
have relay times reserved.**

Late Entries accepted on match day to range capacity.
Teams may be determined on the match day before any team
member begins firing.

ADVANCED ENTRY FEES: \$15 per individual shooter and \$10 per 4 person team

LATE ENTRY FEES: \$20 per individual and \$15 per 4 person team

TARGET SYSTEM: Firing will be done on “TargetWorx” Single bull systems with
NRA approved targets supplied by the National Target Company

SCORING: Scoring will be done by a group assigned by the sponsor and all doubtful
shots **will** be plugged. Scoring on *all* air rifle shots will be done with the
"Outward" Gauge. (NRA Sporter & Precision Position Air Rifles Rule
14).

RELAY TIMES: 0730, 1000, 1230, 1500
(a final 1730 relay may be added if all previous relays are filled)
*Individuals and teams should be at the range check-in at least 1 hour
before their relay to complete their NRA Scorecards. A completed
scorecard MUST be handed to the range officer before targets can be
hung. Relays will not be delayed for late competitors. Late competitors
may fire in a later relay as range capacity permits. No refund of entry fee
will be available to late competitors or teams if they cannot fire in a later
relay.*

Relay Timeline: Each Relay will consist of the following timeline

- 15 Minutes - Equipment to the firing line & Install targets
- 3 Minutes - Preparation period
- 30 Minutes - PRONE
- 5 Minutes - Target retrieval & height change
- 3 Minutes - Preparation period
- 40 Minutes - STANDING
- 5 Minutes - Target retrieval & height change
- 3 Minutes - Preparation period
- 30 Minutes - KNEELING
- 5 Minutes - Target retrieval
- 5 Minutes - Clear equipment from firing line

Approx 2 Hours – 25 Minutes



CHALLENGES & PROTESTS: Handled according to NRA Rule 16

CHALLENGE FEE:

The challenge period will begin when a team's scores are posted and extend for 30 minutes. Only Team Captains will be allowed to view and challenge their team targets.

A challenge fee of \$1.00 per stage may be charged for each challenge made in any position Individual Match.

In Team Matches, a challenge fee of \$1.00 for each team member's score may be charged.

A charge of \$3.00 per individual or \$12.00 per team will be made to challenge another person or team's score.

Note: All shots within a stage may be challenged for one fee.

AWARDS:

Souvenir Awards - Each firing competitor in the Sectional Tournament will be given a souvenir pin to recognize his or her participation in these Sectionals.

Sectional Awards - Awards furnished by NRA. The overall high scoring individual(s) and team will be awarded the Sectional Championship Awards regardless of any categories entered. **For a description of National Awards see the "NRA National Junior Indoor Sectional Championships Program" which can be found on the NRA website (www.nrahq.org)**
