DATES OF MATCH: Sunday, **DECEMBER 19, 2009 (Smallbore Rifle)**

CITY/STATE – LOCATION: Albuquerque, New Mexico – Zia Rifle & Pistol Club Clubhouse
(6 lane - 50 ft indoor range)

ELIGIBILITY: This competition is open to all junior competitors born in 1991 or later.
All competitors must be US Citizens and individual members of USA Shooting.
Membership forms will also be available at the match. Note: Renewing and first time **Junior** memberships are \$20. **There is a “Limited” 6 month Rifle & Pistol membership for \$10 that is for the November thru April timeframe.**

RESIDENCE: Each competitor may claim residence in only one state and must declare the state of residence on the entry form. Residents are eligible for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place USA Shooting State Champion medallions. Non-residents may compete for automatic and at-large invitations to the National Championship and are encouraged to do so.

STATE RESIDENT QUALIFIERS: USA Shooting will issue official invitations to the 2011 National Junior Olympic Shooting Championships (NJOSC) for the high scoring male and high scoring female resident from each State JOSOC, provided they fire a minimum qualifying score. Resident collegiate and/or military competitors are eligible for the state resident champion awards and are also eligible for resident state qualifier invitations.

ENTRY: Shooters may not compete in more than one state JOSOC. Juniors who fire in their own home state JOSOC will not be allowed to shoot in another state. Juniors from states which are not holding a state JOSOC and those who cannot attend their own state JOSOC will be allowed to enter the automatic/at-large division in another state. At entry, non-resident juniors must declare that they are shooting for an at-large/automatic invitation.

Residents may choose to enter the Automatic/At-large category instead of the Resident Qualifier category if they are confident they can shoot above the automatic score and secure an invitation. This would allow another competitor to receive the State Qualifier invitation.

A. Resident Qualifier – Competitors shooting in their declared state of permanent residency. Competitors in this category are eligible to be the state resident qualifier to the National JOSOC.

B. Automatic/At Large – Competitors shooting in other than their declared state of residency are eligible for at-large/automatic invitations to the National JOSOC.

CATEGORIES: The following categories will be used for individual and team competition: **(Age group based on athlete age in 2011)**
Junior (J1); age 18-20: competitors born from 1991-1993
Intermediate Junior (J2); age 15-17: competitors born from 1994-1996
Sub-Junior (J3); age 14 & under: competitors born in 1997 or later.

RULES: Current USA Shooting Rules will govern
Competitors are reminded that it is their responsibility to know and conform to these rules. Copies of the USA Shooting Rulebook may be found on the USA Shooting Website (<http://www.usashooting.com/rulebook.php>)

COURSE OF FIRE: Both Men and Women will shoot a 3x20 match

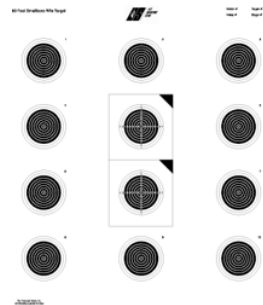
TIME LIMIT: Both Men and Women will have 2 hours and 15 minutes to fire on pre-hung targets

EQUIPMENT: **Eye and Ear protection is mandatory on the Zia ranges.**
In general: Any rifle firing the .22 (5.6mm) Long Rifle **standard velocity** cartridge that conforms to the USA Shooting Rifle Rules is permitted. All Rifles and other equipment must conform to the USA Shooting Rifle Rules.

SIGHTS: Any sight not containing a lens or system of lenses is permitted.
Sights must fully conform to section 7.4.2.3 of the USA Shooting Rules

DISTANCE: 50 feet

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The USA-50 Target

- TARGETS:** USA-50 Targets will be used (2 sighter & 10 Record)
- COACHING:** Coaching will not be permitted after the prep period begins.
- SCORING PROTESTS:** A scoring protest fee of \$1.00 per shot may be charged
- TIES:** All ties will be broken in accordance with current USA Shooting Rules
- PARTICIPATION PINS:** A Junior Olympic participation pin provided by USA Shooting will be given to each competitor.
- AWARDS:** **Provided by USA Shooting** – USA Shooting will provide a gold medallion for the top resident individual, silver medallion for the 2nd place resident individual and a bronze medallion for the 3rd place resident individual. Unused awards must be returned to USAS.
- MAKE ENTRY:** Entries should be made using the entry form enclosed with this program. **Each competitor must have an entry form and LEGIBLE handwriting is required** ... if USA Shooting cannot read your handwriting, you may not get your invitation. A USA Shooting membership form is also enclosed with this program. Make copies of the entry form and membership form as necessary.
- ENTRY FEE:** **TOTAL INDIVIDUAL ENTRY FEES:**
\$12.00 per competitor for advanced entry
\$25.00 per competitor for late entry – up to available lane capacity
(A USA Shooting Registration fee of \$8.00 per individual is included in the entry fee and will be sent to USA Shooting with scores at the completion of the match.)
- ENTRIES CLOSE:** Advance entries will close **Dec 13, 2010**. Entries will be accepted to range capacity. Relays not reserved or requested by Dec 13 will be cancelled. Every effort will be made to accept all competitors who enter before the closing date. Make checks to **VC4HSS**.

- LATE ENTRIES:** Entries made after the closing date will be accepted only up to available range capacity. Late Entries are required to present a USA Shooting membership card or will be required to pay the additional \$10 USA Shooting (Limited) membership fee in addition to the late entry fee.
- CANCELLATIONS:** Cancellations received by December 13, 2010 will receive a full refund.

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

Multiple relays will be fired to accommodate all pre-entered competitors. Competitors checking in after the designated relay time are “late competitors” and may be accommodated in a later relay up to range capacity. The entry fee will not be refunded if there are no later lanes available for late competitors

Each 2-1/4 hour relay will consist of:

- a **5 minute period** will be given to hang targets
- a **10 minute period** will be provided for competitors to bring equipment to the line and setup. All rifles must be brought to the line in a case. When removed from the case the rifle will be made safe, and an Open Chamber Indicator (OCI) is to be inserted. OCI's will be made available
- a **10 minute prep period** will be given – dry fire only –
- **The 2-1/4 hour firing stage.** Competitors will shoot targets in the Prone, Standing, Kneeling order at their own timing. At the end of their firing, the competitor must make their rifle safe and insert their OCI.
- **After all competitors** have completed firing, a 10 minute equipment teardown period will be given

Relay #1 Start Time – 0930 Sunday – December 19, 2010

Relay #2 Start Time – 1230 Sunday – December 19, 2010

Relay #3 Start Time – 1530 Sunday – December 19, 2010

If necessary, an additional relay (Relay #0) will be added Saturday afternoon.

Lanes will be assigned by lottery/draw at check in.

DIRECTIONS TO RANGE:

ZIA RIFLE & PISTOL CLUB

1.8 miles south of Rio Bravo on Broadway to Bobby Foster Road.
East on Bobby Foster Road across I-25 to Los Picaros Road.
Left at the “T” on Los Picaros and follow the signs to Zia Rifle & Pistol Club.

RANGE ACCESS: ZIA Rifle & Pistol Club is a private range.

You must be a member of Zia to get thru the access gate by yourself.

Non-members must be escorted.

At **one hour** before each Relay Start Time (above), a Zia club member will arrive at the gate to unlock and escort the competitors to the clubhouse. The access gate will only be attended at that time. It is the responsibility of the competitor to be at the Zia gate **AT LEAST** one hour before the Relay Start Time to meet the escort. Competitors arriving late and not checking in by the Relay Start Time will be deemed “Late Competitors”.

There is no food or water at Zia, so make sure you bring some food and plenty of water.

OTHER INFORMATION:

- **STATE & AUTOMATIC QUALIFYING SCORES:**

All state Junior Olympic smallbore rifle matches must be conducted using USA Shooting Rules. The course of fire must be 60 shots (3x20) for both men and women at 50 feet.

One male and one female State Qualifier will be invited per state provided they fire above the minimum required “State Qualifier” score. Automatic invitations are issued to all who fire above the minimum “automatic invite” score. Remaining at-large competitors will be ranked by age category and score and invited up to range capacity.
